TOP 500

Qualifications

1. ATA Membership
2. AIM Membership
3. Virginia resident before qualified registered targets are shot
 - If you join before Oct. 31 targets shot in 2010 target year will qualify
4. No eligibility if you have not joined by July 10,2010
5. Targets must be shot at any ATA registered shoot during the 2010 ATA Target Year.

Basic Outline

Contestants will have a minimum of 500 registered targets for average calculation

Registered targets over 500 will be allow lower shoot scores to be dropped from average calculation.

Top 500 registered scores will be used to determine Champion, Runner-up and 3rd in each AIM category.

Targets can be Big 50,100,200 events. Scores for events cannot be broken down to subevents for calculation purposes.(ex. 200 targets events all 200 must either be used /not used).
